

## **SRCAR®** Scholarship Foundation Application

For over 30 years the SRCAR<sup>®</sup> Scholarship Foundation has awarded scholarships to outstanding college bound High School seniors in the Southwest Riverside County area that have family members in the Real Estate Industry.

Scholarships are awarded based on academic performance, accomplishments, and involvement/merit. All senior students with a minimum cumulative overall grade point average of 3.0 at the end of first semester who are planning to attend a two-year community college, four-year university, technical, trade, of a vocational school are eligible to apply. **Applicants are NOT guaranteed a scholarship.** Student will be asked for proof of school registration and must be registered for a minimum of 12 units in order to obtain their scholarship funds.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, the student must:

- Complete the enclosed application
- > Type a one-page answer to the following essay questions:
  - 1. Why should you be considered for a scholarship?
  - 2. What are your goals during college term?
- Submit two letters of recommendation. One must come from a teacher and the other may come from an employer, clergy member, community leader, of family friend. The two letters must be attached to the application
- > Obtain and attach an updated, unofficial transcript from your school counselor
- > Applications and letters should be typed if possible
- Have a minimum cumulative overall GPA average of 3.0
- Have a family member who is a current member of the Southwest Riverside County Association of REALTORS<sup>®</sup>
