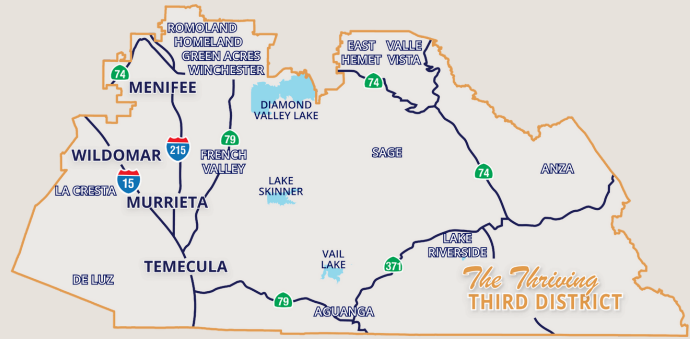

## Key Points:

Through innovative programming like the Recovery Opportunity Center, Riverside County Probation is transforming those struggling into productive members of society who hold stable jobs, secure housing, and become contributing members of our economy.

The District Attorney's Division of Victim Services is celebrating 45 years of ensuring victims of crime are informed and supported throughout the criminal justice process.

April is Innovation Month, and the Office of Economic Development is partnering with cities to sponsor pitch competitions with a chance for businesses to compete in the Startup World Cup.

Riverside University Health System (RUHS) Medical Center continues to earn national recognitions for service excellence. RUHS - Public Health was awarded nearly \$1 million in grants to reduce traffic-related injuries and fatalities. RUHS- Behavioral Health is nearing completion of the 18-acre Wellness Village at a total project cost of \$580 million. Expected to open in early 2027, the community-centric campus will house Riverside County's first Crisis Residential Treatment and Mental Health Urgent Care for children.
